



# 2005 Salary Survey Results Technical Communicators in Huntsville/North Alabama

The following data is appropriate for compensation analysis, because the information is broken down by job function. Note that other factors may have a significant influence, such as whether a communicator works in government or in a company. In addition, other qualitative factors influence compensation, such as specific experience and practices in a given industry. These data are for full-time salaried, agency, and self-employed workers who reported annual income for a full year.
