

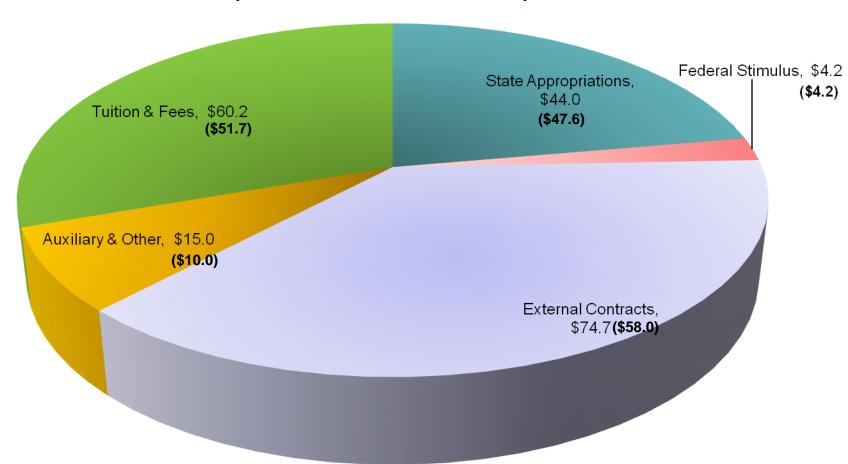

- Provide a balanced budget.
- Salary pool for faculty, staff, & graduate students.
- Investment in Information Technology.
- Investment in student health, wellness, safety, programming, and activities.
- Reallocation of existing resources to critical areas.

2010-11 \$7,492

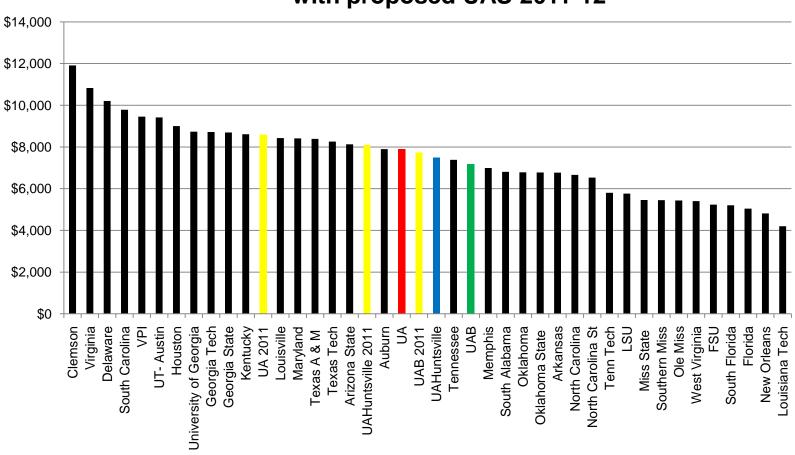
Proposed 8%\* Tuition & Fees Increase 602
