#### Employee Assistance Program (EAP)

- Available to all employees and eligible dependents

- Community resources

#### Primary EAP Services

- Marital and family problems (e.g., divorce, remarriage)
- Stress at home, job related stress
- Workplace conflict
- Alcohol and drug related issues
- Grief and loss
- Life changes
- Behavioral problems
- Legal and financial difficulties
- Emotional problems
- Personal and professional development
- HR and Management consultations



#### Why you have an EAP

- As <u>UAH</u> is committed to the health, safety, and wellness of it's employees, the EAP will support their efforts to keep employees *emotionally* well.
- By being aware of how unresolved personal problems impact work performance and family/personal relationships, employees and dependents may become more productive and effective at home and at work.

#### Three Types of EAP Referrals

#### Employee Self Referral

An employee has a concern for which they are voluntarily seeking assistance.

#### Dependent Self Referral

A Dependent has a concern for which they are voluntarily seeking assistance.

#### Manager/Supervisor Referral

A Manager/Supervisor refers his/her employee to the EAP to help address a work performance issue that remains unresolved.



#### How Does the EAP Work?

- Call the number
- You will be asked some questions about yourself and who you work for
- Inform us if you are in crisis or need emergency assistance
- Briefly state the concerns you have
- Referral is made to a provider
- Your EAP visits will be pre-approved
- Follow up will be handled as needed

# Members are referred to licensed mental health professionals for face-to-face counseling.

Providers are available locally as well as nationwide.



### A wide range of community resources are also available. This includes groups such as:

- Alcoholics Anonymous
- •Grief support groups
- •Divorce recovery groups

#### 24 Hour Crisis Response

- 24 hours/365 days/holidays and weekends
- Answering Service receives the call
- An American Behavioral representative will respond to the call
- Assessment of need will be performed by the representative
- Crises are treated as such
