Request for Program Extension (F1 Students)

Federal law provides an F1 student, who is unable to complete their program before the expiration date listed on the I-20 form, the ability to request an extension of their program. NOT all F1 students will be eligible for an extension of their I-20 end date. Extensions of the end date are only allowable when the student and or academic department can document valid academic or medical reasons that caused the delay in completing their program.

F1 students are required to make normal academic progress toward completing their degree within the time frame listed on their I-20. Delays caused by academic probation or suspension will render a student ineligible for an extension. Academic delays that are deemed valid by immigration require documentation from the academic advisor or major professor. Delays caused by medical conditions require submission of a current letter from a licensed medical doctor or clinical psychologist in Alabama.
