## Welcome Back to UAH!

Your UAH Police Department welcomes everyone back to the fall 2016 semester! We hope everyone had a fun, relaxing and safe summer. As we get back into the swing of things, we're going to cover some good information to keep in mind.

## Parking Permits

Your 2016-2017 parking permits are available now. All students and employees, including part-time students and employees, contractors and adjunct faculty who park a vehicle on campus must pay the annual parking fee, register their vehicle(s) and correctly display a current parking permit. The parking fee for the upcoming academic year will remain at \$120 for an individual vehicle and \$60.00 for each additional vehicle that is parked on the campus. You may pick up your permit at the Parking Management Office, Monday-Friday from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm. All vehicles are required to have an up-to-date permit starting September 1<sup>st</sup>.

## Tobacco/Vapor-free Campus

In case you haven't heard, UAH is now a tobacco and vapor free campus! This is for the overall health and welfare of our community. The move is in accordance with a new policy based on scientific evidence and concerns regarding the negative effects of smoking and vaping. It is intended to provide the university's faculty, staff, students and visitors a campus environment that promotes health and well-being.



The policy prohibits anyone on campus from carrying, inhaling or exhaling any lighted tobacco products, which may include cigarettes, pipes, chewing tobacco and electronic nicotine delivery devices (also known as vaporizers or e-cigarettes).

It applies to all university-owned buildings and vehicles, all outside property including parking and recreational areas, and all indoor and outdoor athletic facilities, as well as to any conferences, meetings, or other public events held on campus.
