# Ready. Set. Go!

August is going to be a hectic time for you and your student. Here are just a few things to keep in mind to better support your new Charger.

- Establish realistic expectations. This can be as simple as how often you and your student will communicate throughout the week. However, this also includes setting academic goals, establishing financial responsibility, and ideals of social involvement.
- Encourage your student to be independent and responsible. Be a supporter and not just a rescuer. This will allow your student to develop problem solving skills within those first weeks of school. Know the resources oncampus to better help direct your student.
  Encourage your student to get involved by



- joining student groups and attending events. We have over 100 events planned the first week of the semester within our Week of Welcome. Tell them not to be afraid - but let them know that these events are the best way to make new friends and create memories.
- 4. Provide reassurance. This environment from the classes to the people they see daily are all new. Remind them that the nervousness that they feel is normal and a lot of other students are feeling it to. Just give it time and effort and you will be a successful Charger.
- 5. Lastly- take care of yourself! Being a better family supporter of a new Charger is to understand how that's going to change your home. Whether it's your first or last to go to college, there will be a period of adjustment. This is a great time to refocus on your own hobbies and interests. Also keep in mind your student still loves you and needs you along this incredible journey they just might forget to say every day.
