Can Creation Rules

I. TIME RESTRAINT

The competition will commence Oct. 15th at 11:00AM, and will conclude at 5:00PM. By 5:30PM competitors should have work areas cleared, clean, ready for their pieces to be judged.

II. MATERIAL

Wood and metal supports are allowed, but may only be used if they are collectively 1/3rd or less than the total size of the sculpture. Canned goods still must be a main component of the sculpture.

III. WHAT TO DO AFTER JUDGING

All competitors must be present at 6:00PM after judging has been completed. Competitors must be present to help deconstruct sculptures so that cans may be properly given to the Food Bank of North Alabama. The cleanup of extra materials is the responsibility of competitors.

IV. PHOTOGRAPHY

Documentation of work is encouraged, as well as sharing pictures online and with friends. The university will take its own photos and will use these in promotional materials.

V. PLEASE DO NOT HARM THE CANS

Entries may NOT puncture cans OR harm the can's labels. HOWEVER, labels MAY be covered by colored material, so long the material does not harm or tear the cans' labels. Paint to cover labels may not be used. Remember that the cans will be donated to the North Alabama Food Bank.

VI. JUDGING

The Official Competition Judges will be selected from among the UAH faculty and staff. The Judges will determine the winners of Canned Creations and their decision is final.

VII. DISCLAIMER

Any entry that is found breaking the rules will be disqualified from the final winners.

VIII. MATERIALS ALLOWED

Extra materials such as wire, wood, and metal are allowed to be used as long as use does not break any of the rules. This includes avoiding harm of the cans.

IX. SAFETY

If working with large tools, safety equipment is highly recommended. Volunteer Chargers will not be at fault for avoiding proper precautions.
