What is PASS?

Peer Assisted Study Sessions (PASS) is a non-remedial academic program that provides peer-led study groups which focus on integrating course content (what to learn) with study skills (how to learn). PASS provides an active learning environment in which students can work together to better understand course content. PASS sessions are facilitated by PASS leaders, current students who have successfully completed the course and who have been trained to make sure that students get those most out of each session.

What does a PASS leader do?

PASS leaders attend a course and facilitate group study sessions outside of class to review and reinforce course content and study strategies. A PASS leader works closely with faculty and students to assist students in academic achievement.

How much time does it take?

PASS leaders work an average of 8 hours per week. They are also expected to attend trainings and professional development seminars, maintain regular contact with the faculty member of the assigned course, and communicate with the PASS Coordinator.

How much are PASS leaders paid?

PASS leader pay begins at \$9.00/hr. PASS leaders have the opportunity to increase their pay through experience and continued professional development, up to \$11.00/hr.

What are the qualifications of a PASS leader?

- Minimum of one semester completed at UAH.
- Completion of the particular course at UAH for which PASS is supported, earning at least a "B."
- 3.0 or higher overall GPA and good academic standing.
- Good interpersonal skills and ease in relating to people from a variety of education, cultural, and social backgrounds.
- Evidence of excellence in responsibility, reliability, and punctuality.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- Current enrollment in 6 credit hours at UAH.
