ALL STUDENTS

UAH enrolls a diverse group of students at various stages in their academic careers. The Office of Admissions requires different documentation based on the appropriate application category, as indicated below. However, these are a few items that are required for all students:

- Completed Undergraduate Admissions Application
- Official transcripts from all institutions, as required by application category
- Official test scores, as required by application category
- Non-refundable application fee:
- \$30 for domestic applications
- \$50 for international applications
- Official credential evaluation of any coursework completed outside of the United States

Freshmen

Students who have completed (or will complete) a high school diploma or its equivalent.

Submit official high school transcripts and standardized test scores directly from the testing agency. We will be unable to accept student copies of the score report. Scores can be ordered by contacting the appropriate agency at:

International

Students who are not U.S. citizens and who have or intend to have a lawful non-immigrant or immigrant status (F or J student visa).

- 1. Submit an Affidavit of Financial Support along with evidence of sufficient funding to cover required expenses for a minimum of 12 months. For more information visit **uah.edu/intladmit/affidavit**.
- 2. Non-native English speakers are required to submit evidence of English language proficiency in the form of an official TOEFL (iBT) or IELTS test score. To schedule an exam or to have previous test results sent to UAH, please contact the appropriate testing agency directly at:

TOEFL exemptions are allowed for students who have:

- Completed at least 2 years at a U.S. high school
- Completed 24 hours of college-level credit, including a freshman composition course, at an accredited U.S. college
 or university

Second Bachelors

Students who have already earned a baccalaureate degree, but who want to pursue a second undergraduate degree.

Request that the Registrar of EACH college or university you have attended, regardless of length of attendance or credits earned, send an official transcript directly to the Office of Admissions.

Transfers

Students who have previously attended an accredited college or university after completing a high school diploma or its equivalent and have at least 24 academic credit hours.

Request that the Registrar of EACH college you have attended (regardless of the length of attendance or credits earned) send an official transcript directly to the Office of Admissions. An official and updated transcript will be required as soon as it is available for any work completed after submitting the Undergraduate Admission Application.

NOTE: Transfer students with fewer than 24 semester credit hours must also submit high school transcripts along with official ACT or SAT test scores.

NON-DEGREE SEEKING STUDENTS

Some students seek courses at UAH without pursuing a degree. These students should apply in the following application categories:

Dual Enrollment & Early Start

Academically talented students may elect to concurrently enroll at UAH after their junior year of high school. Dual Enrollment students can receive both high school and college credit upon successful completion of courses. Early Start students receive college credit upon successful completion of courses.

Required documentation:

- Official high school transcript
- Official test scores from either the ACT or SAT (Please note: We will be unable to accept student copies.)
- An enrollment and permission letter signed by parents/guardians, school counselor, and principal. The form can be downloaded at **uah.edu/admissions/forms**.

The high school retains complete authority over student participation. Contact the Office of Admissions at 256.824.2773 for a complete list of participating schools.

Post-Baccalaureate

A Post-Baccalaureate student is one who has already earned a bachelor's degree and who desires to enroll at UAH for one or more terms to take certain advanced coursework for personal or professional growth. In addition to the application and non-refundable application fee, applicants must submit to the Office of Admissions an official transcript from the college or university from which the baccalaureate degree was earned.

Transient

Students who are currently enrolled at another college but want to take courses at UAH as a visiting student for one term, with credits transferring back to their home institution.

Submit a transient permission letter that confirms the student is:

- In good academic standing
- Eligible to return to the home institution
- Granted permission to enroll in selected courses

The transient permission letter may be submitted on school letterhead, or by downloading the transient student form at uah.edu/admissions/forms.

Non-Degree Students

Students who have earned at least a high school diploma but have no immediate degree plans.

Registration assignments for this category are granted after all degree seeking categories. Non-Degree students are ineligible for financial aid, scholarships, or teaching/research assistantships.

Submit an official high school transcript, GED scores, or college transcript to the Office of Admissions.
