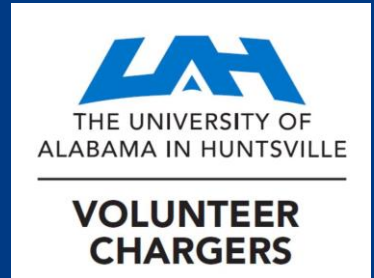


UAH Civic Engagement *UAH Students give back*

Student Success Center (SSC)

The SSC provides academic & career support programs to empower your student to realize their full potential.

Academic questions to ask your student:

- Have you identified what courses you will need extra help on this Spring?
- Do any of your Spring Courses have Pass Leaders?

In each of our Academic Colleges we have a staff member dedicated in helping students to reach their professional career goals. Career services includes resume review and co-op/internship placement.

Career questions to ask your student:

- Are you interested in having a co-op or internship this summer? Do you know how to apply for these positions?
- Have you started working on your resume?

University Fitness Center

The University is an all-inclusive health & fitness center serving our student population.

- Remind your student to re-register with the UFC each semester by bringing in their detailed course schedule. The Fitness Center is at no additional costs for full-time students.

Counseling Center

The Counseling Center is an office staffed by mental health professionals trained to help your student discover ways to cope with problems in living. They support the educational process by assisting students in their academic, personal, and social development. The staff has a commitment to meeting the needs of individuals from diverse backgrounds including differences of culture, race, gender, ability and sexual orientation. Students must be currently enrolled in three or more credit hours to be eligible to receive counseling services. Services at the Counseling Center are all free of charge.

- Counseling sessions are scheduled by appointment. To make an appointment, your student may visit the Counseling Center in Wilson Hall 329, or call [256-824-6203](tel:256-824-6203).

Student Health

The Student Health Center provides on-campus health care to currently enrolled students. The SHC believes good health is essential to optimal success in college. They are here to assist students achieve and maintain their health goals as a step toward the achievement of academic and life goals.
