



HOW TO REGISTER

To be considered for federal financial aid you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and include UAH's school code (001055) so that we receive your information. You should complete the FAFSA as soon as possible after January 1.





REVIEW ACADEMIC PLACEMENT

All first-year students will be sent academic placement letters from the Office of Admissions starting in May. Look for yours in the mail.

Academic Placement letters will show you what courses you have been placed in for English, Math & Chemistry based on your ACT or SAT Scores. Final AP, CLEP & Dual Enrollment could alter your initial placement.
