Early Start is a two week program designed especially for UAHuntsville education majors completing their student teaching in the spring semester. This program engages students in real world experiences with local public school teachers and administrators. Our education majors are allowed to participate as educators make preparations for a new school year.

- ❖ How faculty meetings share vital beginning of the year information.
- ❖ How teachers design instruction with their teammates.
- ❖ How teachers prepare classrooms for the arrival of students.
- ❖ How teachers plan and present student and parent orientation meetings.

During these days you will meet your teacher and attend school-wide opening activities including school system-wide institute day, local school in-service day, teacher work days, parent orientation meetings, and the first week of school.

Early Start Registration

Deadline for registration is Friday, April 6, 2012. This voluntary program will begin with an orientation session on Tuesday, July 31, 2012 from 9-10 a.m. Students placed in Madison City and Madison County Schools will begin their placements on Wed., Aug. 1, 2012; Huntsville City Schools on Fri., Aug. 3, 2012. Placements will be announced during July. Placements will end on Fri., Aug 10, 2012. On Friday, August 10, 2012 from 3-4 p.m., a debriefing session will be held. **Submit registration by Friday, April 6, 2012 to Dept. of Education or Mrs. Patrick in MH 235.**
