

CERTIFICATE IN FOREIGN LANGUAGE AND GLOBAL ENGAGEMENT



The Certificate in Foreign Language and Global Engagement, available for French, German, Russian, and Spanish, is aimed at UAHuntsville students and members of the larger community who wish to acquire officially certified foreign language/culture skills appropriate for global engagement in a breadth of contexts, from research collaboration across the disciplines and professions to medical practice, global trade, the arts, and diplomacy.

Students who successfully complete the certificate will possess intermediate foreign language

proficiency in both oral and written communication appropriate in a variety of everyday situations and professional environments. They will also have basic knowledge of the cultural, economic, political, and historical ramifications of globalization. The certificate will also be noted on students' academic transcripts.
