Other requirements:

• <u>In addition</u> to HY 221 and HY 222, history majors must take a minimum of six (6) semester hours in American history.

• <u>In addition</u> to HY 103 and HY 104 (or HY 101 and HY 102), history majors must take a minimum of six (6) semester hours in non-American history.

• Please note that students must have a **minimum** of thirty-nine (39) hours of 300-and-above courses in their total program to graduate. If you take a 200-level history course beyond the three required, you will have to take an additional 300- or 400-level class, though not necessarily in history.

¹ While required of all history majors in their General Education Requirements (GER), 100-level courses do not count towards the 33 credits needed for the major.

 $^{^2}$ Students may not count more than twelve (12) hours of 200 level work towards the major. This means you may take one (1) 200-level class beyond those required for the major. Please note that if you take four (4) 200-level classes, you will need an additional 300- or 400-level class in order to meet University requirements.

³ Students <u>must</u> take a minimum of twenty-one (21) hours of coursework at the 300- or 400-level. Usually this equals seven (7) classes. Of these upper-division courses, three must be at the 400-level, including HY 490.
