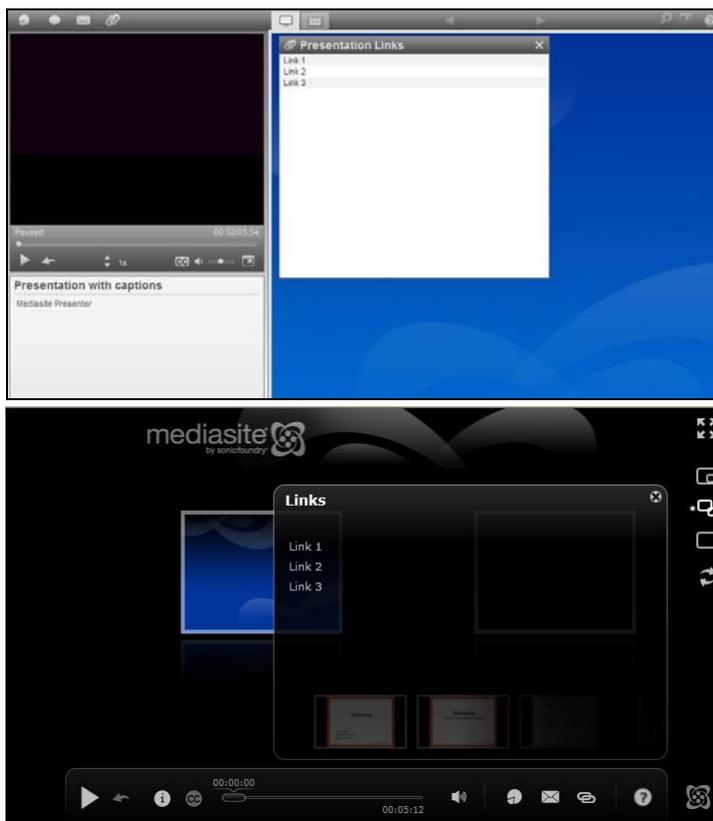


View links

The Links feature is enabled only if links have been added to the presentation.

To view a presentation's links in the Mediasite Player:

1. Click the **View Links** button. A separate window launches with the presentation's links listed.
2. Select the link you want to view. The specified web address will load in another browser window.



View presentation links: HTML Player (top), Silverlight Player (bottom)



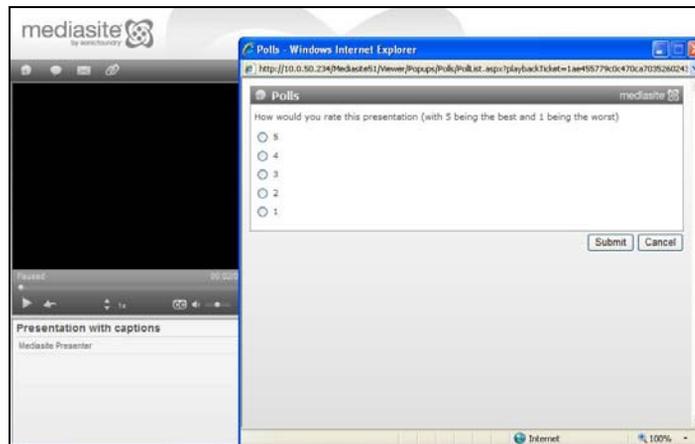

View polls

When polls have been added to a presentation, audience members can answer polls and view poll results in the Mediasite Player.

To view and answer polls in the Mediasite Player:

1. Click the **View Polls** button. A separate window launches with all polls in the presentation listed.
2. Click **Take the Poll** on the same row as the poll you want to answer.
3. Select your answer and click Submit.
4. If this option is available, click **View Results** to see how other people responded to the poll.
5. Click **Back to Polls** to answer the remaining polls in the presentation.



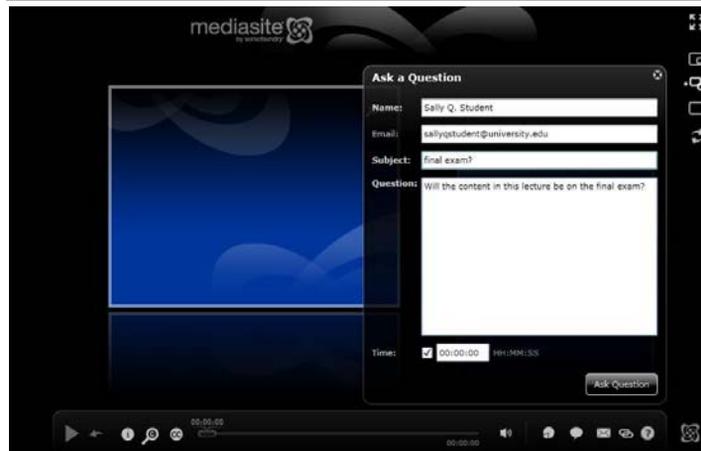
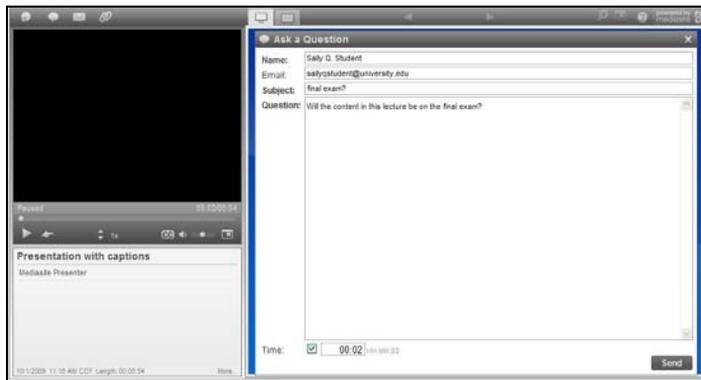
View polls: HTML Player (top), Silverlight Player (bottom)

Ask questions

When the forum feature has been enabled for a presentation, audience members can ask questions using Mediasite Player:

To ask a question:

1. Click the **Ask a Question** button.
2. Enter the subject your question is addressing, your question, name, and email address (optional).
3. Click **Send**. When the confirmation box appears, click **OK**.

When asking a question while viewing an on-demand presentation, if you do not want to include the time in the presentation where you had a question, clear the **Time** check box.
