

Joint Space Weather Summer Camp 2014, July 16 - August 6
– Application Form –

General Information

1. This application is for the selected topics course SPA 489 and SPA 689, *The Joint Space Weather Summer Camp 2014*, and is open to graduate and undergraduate students at UAH. The faculty advisor is Dr. Gary Zank. This course is split into three parts: 1) the first part is a mandatory 1-week introduction to German language and culture, from July 8 - July 14, prior to the Summer Camp; 2) the second part takes place in Germany from July 16 - July 26; 3) the third part takes place in the US (primarily in Huntsville) from July 26 - August 6.
2. This course earns 3 credit-hours.
3. If your application is successful, eligible expenses including transportation, lodging in Germany, and tuition for this course will be covered.
4. *Important notice for applicants/students who work:* Please be aware that for a successful participation in the Space Weather Summer Camp you must attend all classes in both the US and Germany, including the introduction to German language and culture prior to the Summer Camp. This will be very time-consuming! Please make sure that you notify your employer, since it is very likely that you will not be able to work during this course.

Requirements:

1. 3.0 GPA
2. valid passport
3. valid VISA (if applicable)
4. one recommendation (see Recommendation Form)

Application:

A complete application consists of the following forms and documents:

1. Application Form: Complete the following application form in full and save the pdf file as: *Lastname-application-JSWSC2014.pdf* and send it to jswsc@uah.edu. If you have problems filling out the form electronically, you can also print it off and fill it out by hand and bring the application to CSPAR, NSSTC, Rm. 2001.
2. Recommendation Form: Download the recommendation form and fill out the first part of the form. Your evaluator fills out the rest of the form and sends it to jswsc@uah.edu.
3. Unofficial Transcripts: Save your unofficial transcript as a pdf file as *Lastname-transcript-JSWSC2014.pdf* and send it to jswsc@uah.edu.

If you have problems filling out any of the forms electronically, you can also print them off and fill them out by hand and bring them to CSPAR, NSSTC, Rm. 2001. Note that incomplete applications will not be processed.
