"Expansion at Burritt: Dorothy Davidson Rosenwald Schoolhouse and Folklife School"

presented by Caroline Kelly Buncick, Development Director of Burritt on the Mountain. She will join us to discuss the newest addition to Burritt and its relationship to an extremely important part of the Southern African American story. In the early 1900s Booker T. Washington and philanthropist and businessman Julius Rosenwald collaborated to form a foundation that would foster over 5000 educational buildings for many African American communities throughout the Jim Crow South. Caroline will talk about the struggle that black children faced and how these men, together with the black communities, improved the chances of obtaining a quality education for thousands of children. Burritt is building a replica Rosenwald schoolhouse in time for the state's bicentennial and will create an exhibit to educate visitors about this story. The exhibit will reside in the school house's hallway while the classrooms will be used for a new educational program for local 4th graders. The Dorothy Davidson Rosenwald Schoolhouse will also be part of the Burritt Folklife School which will also be a part of the presentation.

This program will be followed by the annual business meeting.
