With more than 2/3 of our students receiving financial assistance of some kind, we are here to help.



Renewal Criteria For Freshman Academic Scholarships and Transfer Scholarships:

- Remain classified as an undergraduate student
- Enroll full-time each consecutive fall and spring term
- Earn a minimum 2.00 UAH GPA each semester
- Earn a minimum of 6 credit hours each semester
- Maintain a minimum cumulative UAH GPA of 3.00
- Earn a minimum of 24 combined credit hours from fall and spring of the same academic year

- Log into myUAH (my.uah.edu)
- Under the "Financial Aid" heading, select "Financial Aid Self-Service"
- Select the Award Year
- Click on "Award Offer"
- Under "Take Action", select "Accept" or "Decline"
- Click "Submit"

The Bursar's Office oversees the billing and collection of fees, adding funds for student accounts, and student refunds.



Bills will be available towards the middle of the summer.

- Tuition and fee charges are added to accounts after course registration.
- Housing charges are added after signing a housing contract with University Housing.
- Meal plans are added via the Charger Card Office.

All charges are due on the first official day of each semester. Tuition bills are not mailed to students. Students may check their account balance at any time by logging in to myUAH.



Authorized Users:

Only authorized users can be given information regarding a student's account. Authorized users should be limited to family and close friends. If a parent/guardian will be making payments onto a student account, the student should follow these steps to grant them access. Please note, "Authorized Users" is only applicable for viewing a student's account, balance, and charges.

- Log into myUAH
- Select "Student Account" under the Bursar section
- On the right, click, "Set up Authorized User"
- Enter their full name, relationship to the student, and email address
- Log in instructions will be sent to the email address entered
