Cyber-Charged is a day camp program that teaches first principles of cybersecurity in a fun, hands-on environment. Students learn about the building blocks of a computer, programming in python, computer operating systems and software, cybersecurity first principles, cyber-threats, cyber-defenses, network security, firewalls, and virus scanning. Our camps are designed for beginners to intermediates in cybersecurity and computing.
