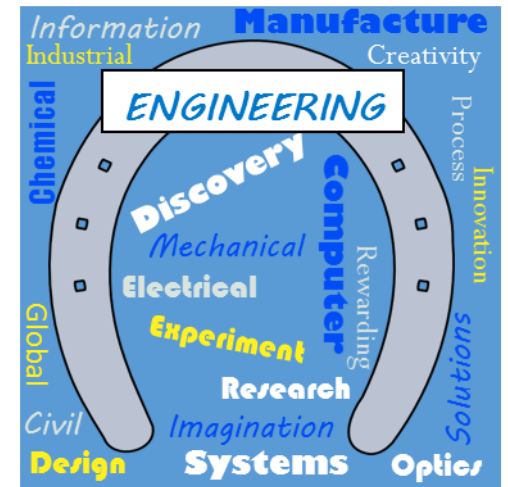

- Hands-on activities, classroom learning, lab tours

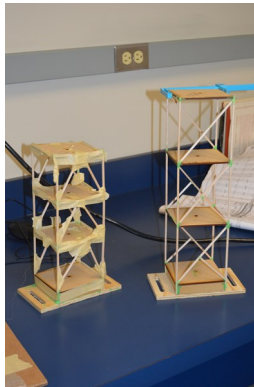
Charger Engineer Adventurers
