Girls in Science and Engineering Day (GSED) is all about STEM discovery and hands-on activities for girls in the 3rd-5th grade and held on the UAH campus. Girls will participate in a variety of workshops designed to spark their curiosity and excitement about science, engineering and technology.

Girls will be divided into groups and rotate through a series of STEM workshops. Each group will be escorted/supervised at all times. Girls will receive a GSED T-shirt, goody bag, water bottle, and snacks.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who is eligible to attend?

Girls in the 3rd-5th grades (as of August 31, 2021).

Can family members attend?

Family members are not permitted to escort their child.

What happens at the event?

Girls are divided into groups of 20 which are monitored by three counselors. Each group will follow a schedule (see typical schedule below). Girls will participate in hands-on STEM workshops and learn about opportunities for women in STEM.

Typical Schedule

9:25 am-10:05 am—Workshop 1

10:05 am to 10:45 am—Workshop 2

10:45 am to 11:15 am—Snack, Water, Restroom break

11:15 am to 11:55 am—Workshop 3

12:00 pm to 12:30 pm—STEM Demonstration

12:30 pm—Check-out

What kind of snacks are provided?

Girls will receive a water bottle and a choice of snacks. No peanut/tree nuts snacks will be available. Gluten-free and dairy-free options will be provided.
