


UAH's new Air Force ROTC operating location takes off with 30 cadets

In August, UAH announced the official activation of its Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) operating location — the first Air Force or Space Force ROTC program of its kind in the U.S. Available to freshmen and sophomores, the program will allow scholarship and non-scholarship cadets

to live as regular college students while pursuing their degrees. Once they graduate, they will be commissioned in the U.S. Air Force or U.S. Space Force.



UAH researcher wins NASA FINESST scholarship to study connection between solar wind turbulence and energetic particles

Ashok Silwal, a graduate research assistant of Space Science, has received a NASA Future Investigators in NASA Earth and Space Science and Technology (FINESST) scholarship to study stream interaction regions (SIRs) in the heliosphere. SIRs accelerate energetic particles, impacting the interaction between the solar wind and the Earth's magnetosphere, a fundamental mystery in heliophysics.
