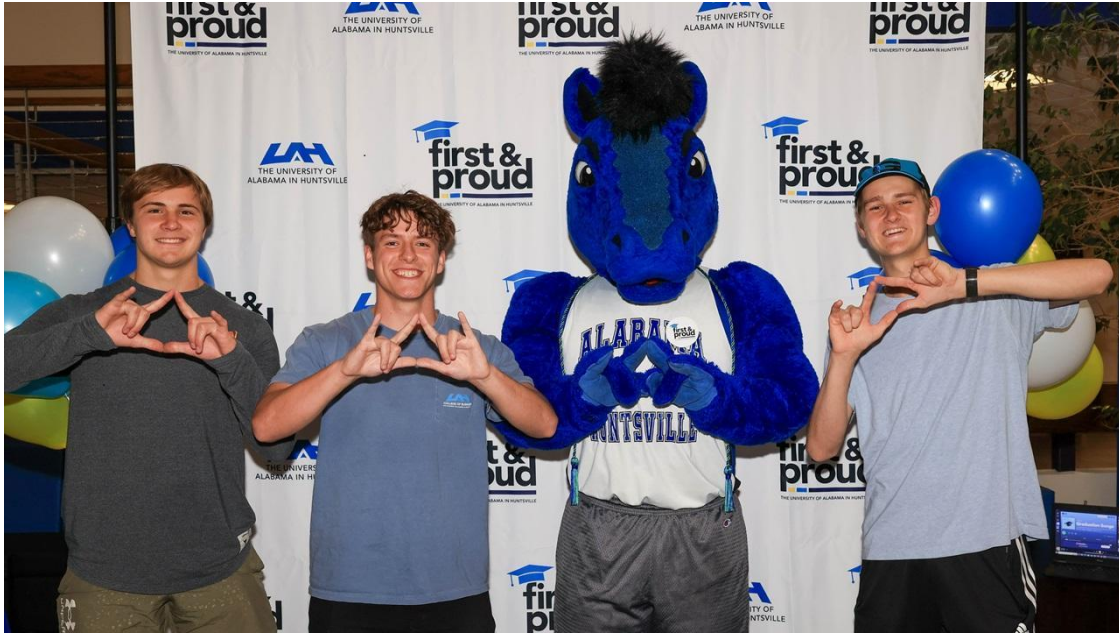


UAH dedicates Black Box Theatre in memory of longtime professor Dr. Robert E. James
