UAH wins \$1.35M Army grant to advance human interactions with

artificial intelligence

An interdisciplinary faculty group from UAH has been awarded a \$1.35 million grant from the <u>U.S. Army</u> <u>Combat Capabilities Development Command Analysis Center</u> to support advancements in human-systems integration analysis and artificial intelligence (AI).

"Modern, complex systems, such as autonomous systems, are fundamentally interdisciplinary," says Dr. Bryan Mesmer, the principal investigator and associate professor of Industrial & Systems Engineering and Engineering Management (ISEEM). "To address the challenges associated with these interdisciplinary systems, it is necessary to approach them through an interdisciplinary lens."
