

UAH researcher awarded NASA FINESST grant to research 3D-printed lunar concrete

Ledia Shehu, a doctoral student at UAH, has been selected to receive a NASA Future Investigators in NASA Earth and Space Science and Technology (FINESST) grant to develop a multiscale model for 3D-printed concrete using lunar materials.

"Sending materials to the moon is incredibly expensive," she says. "Our solution – using lunar materials to create printable and buildable concrete – will significantly reduce costs and provide a more practical approach to building on the moon."
