**Senate Resolution 11-12/09: Integrity and Transparency for
Behavior Tracking System Information**

Bill History: 10/20/11 Before FSEC as S.B. 360, sent to Personnel
11/17/11 Personnel reported back to EC on potential revisions
01/19/12 Before FSEC from Personnel, with revisions, next step debated w/o final disposition
02/16/12 FSEC sent bill to Senate floor for action (First Reading passed)
02/23/12 Approved at Second Reading
03/15/12 Approved at Third Reading; Becomes S.R. 11-12/09

1 **WHEREAS,** The University has a Behavioral Evaluation and Threat Assessment (BETA)
2 policy that institutes policies and procedures for collecting information and
3 monitoring individuals reported to be behaving in certain ways (even those
4 exhibiting “Low Risk” behavior), culminating in the formation of a BETA
5 Team; and

7 **WHEREAS,** The policy has many questionable omissions, including the fact that it does
8 not require disclosure of the reported behavior to the individual at question,
9 and
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11 **WHEREAS,** The policy has many questionable requirements, including the fact that
12 Individuals may be “reported” and not know they were reported or that they
13 are being monitored, and
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15 **WHEREAS,** There appears to have been minimal input from UAH faculty, staff and
16 students, the main constituencies affected by this policy,
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18 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**

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20 That the Behavioral Evaluation and Threat Assessment policy be reworked
21 completely by an ad-hoc committee with the participation of members of the UAH faculty, staff
22 and students as well as personnel that wrote the original version of the bill.

24 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**

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26 That the ad-hoc committee produce a new version of the Behavioral
27 Evaluation and Threat Assessment policy, before the beginning of the 2012-2013 academic year.
