# **Change to History Minor**

#### JUSTIFICATION:

In its current form, the History Minor requires 21 hours beyond HY 103 and HY 104 in Charger Foundations; the pre-minor requirements make it in practice a 27 hour minor. The History Department wishes to reduce the hours of the minor as a means of making it a more appealing option for students. This is especially important since the college has in recent times moved to a 120 hour degree; as part of this change the department reduced the hours of our major from 36 to 30. The new 30 hour major is only three semester hours more than our current minor. We plan to eliminate pre-minor requirements and to count either the 100-level World History survey sequence or the 200-level US History survey sequence within the minor. These new requirements will create a 21 hour minor.

#### **CURRENT HY MINOR**

#### From Undergraduate catalog:

A student interested in establishing a history minor must take a minimum of 21 semester hours of history beyond HY 103 or HY 104 (GER) and including:

- 9 semester hours in courses numbered 200 or above.
- 12 semester hours in courses numbered 300 or above.
- HY 290 is strongly recommended.
