# PCS-hosted Storytelling & Barbeque

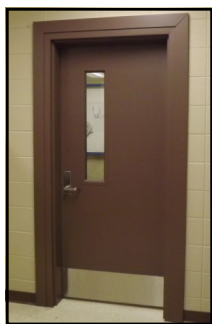

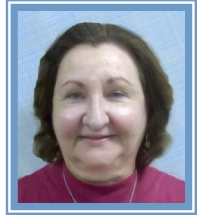
