





Changes, Life is Full of Changes

The Osher Lifelong Learning Institute, and, by extension, all of its members receives many benefits and courtesies from UAH. Among these are the buildings and classrooms that we occupy along with the infrastructure to support the facilities, the parking lot, and the PCS staff dedicated to OLLI's success. Although it is obvious, perhaps we sometimes forget that all of these benefits must be shared and prioritized. Convenient parking has been a difficulty all over campus and to address this the administration has instituted some changes to help the congestion. One thing you will notice when you come on campus is the change to Zoned Parking. OLLI now has a designated area for Commuter Parking.

Unlike employees and students, OLLI members receive a free parking pass each term. Completion of an OLLI Permit Application is required BEFORE a parking pass is issued, therefore permits will no longer be mailed. The application requires vehicle year, make, color, and type. Your driver's license number, state of issue, and license plate number will also be required. T

There are three ways to obtain your parking permit:

- 1. In person, at the time of registration in Wilson Hall 103
- 2. During the OLLI Open House, Wed, Aug 30, 2 4 pm
- 3. In Wilson Hall lobby on the day of your first fall-term class

If you are NOT registered for term courses, but plan to attend other OLLI activities on campus, please select one of the following to avoid parking fines:

- 1. Purchase an OLLI Term Parking Permit at the discounted rate of \$10 from the Registration Office, Wilson Hall 103
- 2. Obtain a Free Visitor's Parking Pass for up to 1 week from the UAH Police Department
- 3. Purchase a year-long UAH Parking Decal at the UAH Police Department for \$120

Reminder

OLLI provides free coffee in the OLLI lounge (Room 152-C of Wilson Hall). Sometimes Member Interest Groups or classes meet in the lounge. If there is a class, a class notice will be posted beside the door. Please do not enter the room if a class is in session.

The Support Fund Committee's goal is to raise money to support the operation of the OLLI program at UAH. Philanthropist, Bernard Osher has created 120 Osher Lifelong Learning Institutes with his philanthropy, but with the caveat that they should become self-supporting organizations. This is why, like most OLLI's nationwide, we have created an annual member donation fund —The Support Fund. For the 2015-2016 year we were fortunate to collect a little over \$14,000 from our OLLI members to help meet the Osher goal. This year, 2016-17, we have exceeded this amount and have a donation rate of 10% of our members. These donations are important to keep the quality OLLI program we have now with its large number of quality courses.

The Support Fund communicates with the OLLI members via emails and written letters a couple of times a year. Perhaps even more important are the reminders the facilitators give at the beginning of all the OLLI classes.

From AARP Bulletin, June 2017:

A new state law allows Alabamians with disabilities to save for their future needs without adversely affecting their benefits from programs like Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Medicaid. Under the *Achieving a Better Life Experience* (ABLE) Act, people with disabilities can put up to \$14,000 a year into a tax-exempt savings account to pay for expenses that enhance their quality of life. Family members and friends may contribute, and total assets can grow to \$100,000 without disqualifying the account holder from SSI or Medicaid. Previously, people with disabilities were ineligible for such benefits if they had more than \$2,000 in assets.
