<u>Purpose</u>	Establish the composition, structure, and role of the Honors Council.
<u>Policy</u>	The Honors College has an advisory council, named the Honors Council, composed of faculty, students and staff who provide guidance to the Honors Dean on the development, performance and future of the Honors College. This policy establishes the composition of the Honors Council and defines its role.

Procedures

Composition and Structure:

The Honors Council is composed of the following members:

- One tenure-earning or tenured faculty member from each College, appointed by the Dean of each college in consultation with the Honors Dean. The council member from the College of Nursing will be the Director of Honors Nursing.
- Two students: the Chair of the Honors Student Mentor Program and the Chair of the Honors College Ambassadors
- The Associate Director of Housing
- The Resident Director of Honors Housing
- The Student Undergraduate Research Program Coordinator

These members are appointed to one-year terms from August 15 to August 14 of the following year. Terms are renewable for no more than two consecutive terms, except for the Director of Honors Nursing, who will serve for as long s/he holds that position.

The Executive Committee of the Honors Council consists of the appointed faculty members from each college.

The Honors College Dean chairs the Council as a non-voting member.

Role:


The entire Honors Council advises the Dean on the development and vision of the College, undergraduate research, college operations, and issues related to the academic programming and the Honors Community in Honors Housing.

The Executive Committee advises the Dean on issues related to student academic misconduct, reinstatement of students dropped from the program, and on issues of Honors Curriculum.

Review

The Honors Dean, in consultation with the entire Honors Council, will review these policies every 5 years and as needed. This policy was last reviewed in November 2014, and will require review again in November 2019
