As you know, we engaged Huron Education, a national consulting firm, for a portion of this past calendar year to assess our enrollment management strategies and tactics and make recommendations for future efforts that will assist us in meeting target enrollment objectives. One of their recommendations was to consolidate all student-facing services in one division under a Vice President for Student Affairs. We are proceeding with implementation of that recommendation, as well as constructing a welcome center and student services building to replace Madison Hall, so we can consolidate student services in one facility.
