RE: Exterior Wayfinding Signage

Progress continues on the installation of the new campus exterior wayfinding signage. Approximately 85 percent of the signs have been installed, and the work on this aspect of our signage project should be complete in the coming weeks. We recognize that some modifications and/or adjustments may need to be made, but they are minor in nature.

A document that offers way finding terminology that includes campus entrance names, a campus map, building name codes, and campus parking identification can be found on myUAH under Administration, Campus Growth & Improvements, Exterior Wayfinding. By using this terminology, wayfinding should be improved by providing visitors with the name of the entrance they should use, a three-letter code for each building, as well as identification of parking lots that would be in close proximity to their destination.
