Welcome students! On behalf of the faculty and staff of UAH, we're excited to start a new academic year with you. Please review the following information.

2023 Fall Calendar. As you start the fall semester, please be aware of the important dates for the session in which you are enrolled. The [dates and deadlines](#) for drop/add, drop with refund, final exams, and others are posted on the Registrar's website.

Drop/Add. Students may add courses without special approvals and may drop courses and receive a refund up until the last drop/add date given for the semester or term. After the drop/add date, students must have approval to make schedule changes and cannot receive a refund for dropped courses. Please also keep in mind that **not attending class does not equate to dropping it**; students will still be responsible for tuition charges if they do not drop unwanted courses. Pay attention to the dates for the specific part of the term in which you are enrolled.
