Welcome back for the start of the spring semester! Please review the following information.

Academic Continuity

Please develop a clear academic continuity plan and be prepared to communicate that plan to your students in the event of inclement weather, illness, etc. COVID-19 spread *may* necessitate a pivot to remote instruction for a temporary period. Face Coverings Indoors
