

CHARGER *Checklist*

CONGRATULATIONS on your admission to UAH!

☐ **Access myUAH & Your UAH Email - uah.edu/getstarted**

- Visit uah.edu/getstarted for instructions on accessing your student accounts, setting your UAH password, and configuring multi-factor authentication. These steps must be completed within 30 days of being admitted to avoid being locked out of your student accounts.

Provide Emergency Contact Information: If an emergency arises that impacts you as an individual, UAH will refer to your emergency contact information. It is important to enter an emergency contact under "Personal Information" in your myUAH account.

☐ **Pay Your Bill or Enroll in a Payment Plan - uah.edu/bursar**

- All charges are due on the first official day of class each semester. Please note that tuition bills are not mailed to students. Tuition and fee charges are added to accounts after course registration. Payment options can be viewed at uah.edu/bursar.
- UAH provides an automatic half-tuition scholarship for each course taken. This scholarship will be applied to tuition and does not cover fees.

☐ **Submit Your Immunization Records - uah.edu/wellness/forms**

- Complete the Immunization Form and Tuberculosis Risk Questionnaire and upload to the Charger Health Portal at uahportal.pointnclick.com. For more information or assistance, contact the Student Health Center at 256.824.6948 or immunizations@uah.edu.

☐ **Review Your Charger Course Pack - uah.edu/bookstore**

- Charger Course Pack is a program designed to lower the cost of course materials and ensure students have access to all required materials by the first day of class. All undergraduate students are automatically enrolled into the program. Students have the option to opt out each semester during the opt-out window.

☐ **Register for Your Parking Permit - parking.uah.edu**

- All students who plan to park a vehicle on campus must have a valid parking permit for the entire academic year.

☐ **Set Up Your Mobile Charger ID - uah.edu/charger-card**

- After you are registered for classes, follow the guidelines for setting up your mobile Charger ID, including submitting your ID photos, creating your Charger ID credentials, and setting up multi-factor authentication.

☐ **Stay Connected**

- Regularly check your @uah.edu email address to stay in contact with UAH faculty and staff, receive campus announcements, and be updated about your myUAH account.
- Visit uah.edu/events to stay in the loop with upcoming campus events.
- Register for UAlert, UAH's emergency notification system at uah.edu/ualert. UAlert allows UAH to quickly disseminate urgent messages via voicemail, text, and email.
- Follow UAH on social media at uah.edu/social.

Frequently Asked Questions ABOUT DUAL ENROLLMENT

1. How do I register for my class(es)

Once admitted to UAH, the Dual Enrollment Coordinator will register you for the class(es) you requested on your dual enrollment form. You will receive a confirmation email with the status of your registration.

2. How much does it cost?

UAH provides a half-tuition scholarship for each dual enrollment course you take. This is an automatic scholarship and is only applied to tuition. It does not cover fees. Please visit uah.edu/bursar/tuition for current tuition rates and fees.

3. When is tuition paid?

Tuition is due on the first day of classes. You may set up a payment plan through the Bursar's Office, and you may also choose to begin payments earlier than the first day of class.

4. How do I access my student accounts?


To access your myUAH account and UAH email, visit uah.edu/getstarted and follow the instructions for setting your password and multi-factor authentication. These steps must be completed within 30 days of being admitted to avoid being locked out of your accounts.

5. How is parking handled?

All students who plan to park on campus are required to purchase a parking decal. Parking decals can be purchased online at parking.uah.edu.

6. How does my high school receive my final course grade?

UAH will automatically send your final grade to your high school at the end of the semester, so you do not have to request for it to be sent yourself. If you have any unpaid tuition, parking tickets, or fees of any kind, UAH will not be able to send your transcript until those fees are paid.
