

The Harry H. Watters Memorial Scholarship for Excellence in Jazz

The Harry H. Watters Memorial Scholarship for Excellence in Jazz is awarded with preference to students who participate in the jazz program at the university, demonstrate excellence in jazz, and participate in community

Established in 2001 this scholarship was created in loving memory of Harry Watters by his wife Judy, sons Ken and Harry, colleagues, and friends. Mr. Watters worked as an aerospace engineer for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) for 35 years. Throughout his life Mr. Watters enriched many educational and community programs with his enthusiastic support, including the music programs at UAH.

This scholarship is for one year only; however, recipients may re-apply to be eligible for possible renewal for up to three additional years of scholarship award. The student must maintain a full-time course load (12 credit hours) each semester. In addition, recipients must complete a total of 24 credit hours each academic year, have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, and must submit a scholarship application by the priority deadline to be eligible for possible renewal. Students should submit a scholarship application every year in order to update their file and possibly be eligible for other awards.
