

The Professor D. Royce Boyer Music Scholarship

The Professor D. Royce Boyer Music Scholarship is awarded to an upper-level undergraduate student who exhibits outstanding participation in performing arts programs at the university and demonstrates good university citizenship. Preference is given to music majors.

Established in 2001, the scholarship honors Dr. Boyer's achievements as an educator, musician, and community leader. He served as a member of the music faculty until his retirement in 1997 after 31 years of outstanding service. As a professor of Music, Dr. Boyer provided extraordinary leadership in establishing the UAH Department of Music.

This scholarship is for one year only; however, recipients may re-apply to be eligible for possible renewal for one additional year of scholarship award. The student must maintain a full-time course load (12 credit hours) each semester. In addition, recipients must complete a total of 24 credit hours each academic year, have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, and must submit a scholarship application by the priority deadline to be eligible for possible renewal. Students should submit a scholarship application every year in order to update their file and possibly be eligible for other awards.
