

## **The Robert E. James Communication Arts Scholarship**

The Robert E. James Communication Arts Scholarship is awarded with preference given to full-time students who are majoring in Communication Arts and who have completed a minimum of twelve credit hours of Communications Arts classes at UAH. The award is based on academics, citizenship, and exhibition of potential.

The scholarship was established in 2002 in honor of Dr. Robert E. James, who served as chairman of the committee that oversaw the development and approval of a minor in Communication Arts within the College of Liberal Arts. Dr. James served as acting chair of the department from 1993-1996 and as interim chair in the fall of 2002.

This scholarship is a one-year award and is not renewable. The student must maintain a full-time course load (12 credit hours) and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. Students should submit a scholarship application every year in order to update their files and possibly be eligible for other awards.
