

## **The Pamela Mitchell Memorial Scholarship**

The Pamela Mitchell Memorial Scholarship is based on the recipient's ability to combine the best elements of mind and body to achieve distinction for her achievements, and determination to be a future leader in her chosen career.

Established in 2000, this scholarship award is the highest UAH honor that can be bestowed upon a female athlete. The scholarship is named in memory of Pamela Mitchell, who served in the Madison County District Attorney's Office for many years. As a strong proponent of public service, she supported many community programs including UAH. This scholarship will help outstanding students pursue a college education, and inspire young people to make professional excellence a part of their lives as Ms. Mitchell did in hers.

This scholarship is a one-year award and is not renewable. The student must maintain a full-time course load (12 credit hours) and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. Students should submit a scholarship application every year in order to update their files and possibly be eligible for other awards.
