

Edwin B DeVault Engineering Scholarship

The Edwin B. DeVault Engineering Scholarship was established in 1982 by the DeVault family to benefit undergraduate students pursuing a degree in mechanical engineering. Edwin was a World War II Veteran of the U.S. Navy and spent three years in the South Pacific as an aviation mechanic. He attended the University of Tennessee and completed his engineering studies at Auburn University where he was a member of the Pi Tau Sigma honorary fraternity. Mr. DeVault was a Registered Professional Engineer and spent most of his engineering career working in the manufacturing and production industry in Huntsville, Alabama. Edwin was Vice President of DeVault Ultra Precision, Inc. at the time of his death.

This scholarship is awarded to an undergraduate student at the Junior or Senior level who is majoring in Mechanical Engineering. Candidates must have at least a 3.0 cumulative UAH GPA and be studying full time. Candidates must also be residents of the State of Alabama and demonstrate financial need. The Edwin B DeVault Engineering Scholarship is renewable for up to two additional years.
