

Bryant Bank Excellence in Nursing Scholarship

The Bryant Bank Excellence in Nursing Scholarship was established in 2015 to award in-state students admitted to the Early Promotion into the UAH Nursing Program (EPNP). The EPNP is a new honors program being offered by UAH's College of Nursing. Highly qualified students who enter UAH as freshmen declaring nursing as their major and taking all of the lower division nursing coursework on the UAH campus are guaranteed a slot in upper division nursing courses.

Bryant Bank was founded on the belief that Alabama needs a bank that is focused on the needs of Alabamians. It was granted a charter by the State of Alabama Banking Department on June 10, 2005. The company has 14 branches in Alabama, including two in Huntsville. The first Huntsville branch opened in 2007.

This scholarship is renewable. If renewed, the value will adjust per year to reflect the cost of the Nursing Program in conjunction with the recipient's existing Merit Tuition scholarship.

Renewal requirements:

- A full-time course load (12 hours) must be maintained each semester
 - Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 on all lower division Nursing and Charger Foundation required courses given in the BSN lower division program of study
 - Successful completion of the required BSN lower division program of study for promotion into upper division nursing courses at the end of the sophomore year
 - An overall cumulative score of at least 80% on the HESI Admissions Assessment (A2) exam at the end of the sophomore year
-
