

The College of Nursing Dean's Scholarship

The College of Nursing Dean's Scholarship is awarded to a student who is majoring in Nursing. The award is based on academic merit.

Contributors to this scholarship, which was established in 1989, include former students, faculty, friends and staff of the College of Nursing.

This scholarship is renewable for up to three additional years. The student must maintain a full-time course load (undergraduate - 12 credit hours, or graduate - 9 credit hours) each semester. In addition, recipients must complete a total of 24 credit hours (graduate – 18 credit hours) each academic year and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be eligible for renewal. Students should submit a scholarship application every year in order to update their files and possibly be eligible for other awards.
