

Bruce and Lisa Askins Science and Engineering Scholarship

The Bruce and Lisa Askins Science and Engineering Scholarship is awarded to students enrolled in the College of Engineering or the College of Science with no specified area of concentration.

The Askins Scholarship was established in 2003 in support of the College of Science and the College of Engineering. Bruce Askins graduated from the UAH College of Engineering in 1987 and is employed by NASA as a Senior Mechanical Engineer. He has continued to remain an active leader in the UAH community where he previously served as a member of the Alumni Association Board of Directors from 1988 to 2003 and as president of the board in 1993-1994.

This scholarship is renewable for up to three additional years. Recipients must maintain a full-time course load (12 hours) each semester and must complete a total of 24 credit hours each academic year with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be eligible for renewal. Students should submit a scholarship application every year in order to update their files and possibly be eligible for other awards.
