

The Gary S. Lindsay Memorial Scholarship

The Gary S. Lindsay Memorial Scholarship is awarded to an Engineering or Computer Science student with preference given to juniors, and is based on academic merit, leadership ability, and the inclination for contributing to the improvement of their communities through positive personal and professional attributes.

The scholarship was established in 1988 by Mr. Lindsay's friends and colleagues in celebration of the many positive contributions that he made during his life. Mr. Lindsay was an engineer with Teledyne Brown Engineering, Inc. He is fondly remembered by his colleagues and friends for his willingness to serve as a mentor to young professionals, his collegiality and appreciation of life, and his outstanding leadership.

This scholarship is renewable for up to one additional year. The student must maintain a full-time course load (12 credit hours) each semester. In addition, recipients must complete a total of 24 credit hours each academic year and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be eligible for renewal. Students should submit a scholarship application every year in order to update their files and possibly be eligible for other awards.
