

The Jane Knight Lowe Memorial Scholarship

The Jane Knight Lowe Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a full-time student, with preference given to entering freshmen that received a high school diploma or equivalent while residing in Madison County, Alabama. The award is based on academic merit with financial need as a secondary consideration.

The Trustees of the Jane K. Lowe Charitable Foundation established this scholarship in 2002 in loving memory of Jane Knight Lowe. Mrs. Lowe was a prominent citizen of Huntsville who was a generous benefactor and civic leader in the community and a patron of countless civic and community programs.

This scholarship is renewable for up to three additional years. The student must maintain a full-time course load (12 credit hours) each semester. In addition, recipients must complete a total of 24 credit hours each academic year and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be eligible for renewal. Students should submit a scholarship application every year in order to update their files and possibly be eligible for other awards.
