

## **The Terry C. Baughman Scholarship**

The Terry C. Baughman Scholarship is awarded based on academic merit with preference to employees and children of employees of Wesfam Restaurants, Inc. and applicants with demonstrated financial need.

The scholarship was established in 2005 by Jean Wessel Templeton, a member of the UAH Foundation Board, to honor her brother Terry. He has served thirty-five years with Jean's company, Wesfam Restaurants, Inc., a long-time Burger King franchise organization in North Alabama. As Vice-President of Operations and President, he has led the company to many national awards and recognitions for operational excellence.

This scholarship is renewable for up to four additional years. The student must maintain a full-time course load (12 credit hours) each semester. In addition, recipients must complete a total of 24 credit hours each academic year and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be eligible for renewal. Students should submit a scholarship application every year in order to update their files and possibly be eligible for other awards.
