Book Arts: Notebook with Postcard Pocket

Description: Learn how to create a hand-stitched notebook that includes a pocket for postcards! Each student will fold a pocket and bind the pages of their notebook. Afterwards, they can decorate postcards and the pages of their books.

Build A Game

Photograms: Cameraless Photography

Description: The word **Photography** comes from the Greek **phos** and **graphe-** <u>Light Writing</u>, or <u>Writing with Light</u>. The simplest photographic prints are actually made without a camera. We can place objects on light-sensitive paper to preserve their shadows created by light. The results are called *Photograms*; "**gram"** is a written character, in this case made with light. Learning this technique will inspire creativity and help students appreciate the magic of **Photography**.
