Biography

Ken Ortlepp has sustained an active career as a performer and teacher. He has appeared as a hornist with several orchestras and ensembles, including the Mississippi Symphony, Mobile Symphony, Memphis Symphony, North Mississippi Symphony Orchestra, Louisiana Philharmonic Orchestra, Fort Collins Symphony, Denver Brass, and the Columbus Symphony Orchestra.
