Upon admission, each DNP student will receive an individualized Plan of Study (POS). This Plan will be specifically tailored to the student's admission term and their chosen full-time or part-time pathway. The sequence of courses may vary depending on semester availability.

*NUR 734 will be added for Nursing Administration because the Master degree in this track requires only 225 clinical hours. NUR 734 is taken to increase the clinical in the Master Program of Study to 500 hours. A total of 1,000 clinical hours are required for the DNP program (500 in MSN program and 500 in DNP program). Maximum allowable NUR 734 hours are 4 per semester.

**A total of 7 hours of NUR 739 is required. Taken over several semesters as determined by Graduate Faculty Chair.
