

A cybersecurity summer camp for deaf and hardof-hearing high school students, hosted at the University of Alabama in Huntsville



Students will engage in a 5 day **residential** camp at UAH where they will learn basic cybersecurity and STEM skills through hands-on experiences and group activities. Students must be entering 10th, 11th, or 12th grade in the Fall of 2017 to be eligible. The camp assumes no prior knowledge in cybersecurity and only requires a basic understanding of computers.
